Free Tutoring and Library Support

Tutor.com, USG eCampus STEM tutors, and USG eCampus librarians assist students with a variety of subjects and information needs.



Helpdesk for Live Support

Open Monday through Thursday 8 AM to 8 PM and Friday 8 AM to 5 PM, the Helpdesk provides student support via phone, email, and IM chat, including our AI-assisted chatbot, eVA.



Intervention and Ongoing Outreach

Professors submit at-risk students for additional outreach and support from USG eCampus team members. Reminders are sent via text and email to students periodically throughout the term regarding important upcoming dates and policies.

Academic Calendar

The eCore calendar does not always align with the institution's academic calendar. Start, add/drop, withdraw, and end dates can all differ.

eCore offers full session and short sessions I and II courses. Short session courses are faster paced, so students should keep this in mind when registering and plan accordingly.

Proctored Exams

A proctored exam and/or video major project is required. Proctors may charge a small cost and could require the download of additional software.

Registration

Students are required to complete the [eCore Intro Quiz](#) before they register for an eCore course.

If students receive an error during registration, such as "Pre-Req Test Score Error," when attempting to register for an eCore course, that most likely means they have not completed the quiz.

Markers for Success in Online Classes



- ✓ Registers early with a planned course load.
- ✓ Has successful grades in other courses.
- ✓ Has completed one or more online courses successfully in the past.
- ✓ Maintains good academic standing at their institution.
- ✓ Displays good time management and task prioritization skills.
- ✓ Completes the optional eConnection Tutorial in GoVIEW to become familiar with accessing course content and navigating links.
- ✓ Logs in on the first day of classes.
- ✓ Completes **Mandatory Attendance** activities before they are due.
