Admission Requirements

To qualify for admission into CSU's RN to BSN program, applicants must:

- be admitted to Columbus State University,
- hold a valid nursing license,
- have a minimum 2.5 GPA on all nursing prerequisite courses, and
- be on good academic standing with all previously attended nursing programs.

Why get a BSN?

Nurses with a BSN are typically given more responsibility, supervisory roles, and higher salaries which can open doors to enhance your career.
