Why a BSED – Special Education?

The Bachelor of Science in Education – Special Education (BSED-SPED) program prepares students to enter the field of special education and address Georgia’s growing need for highly qualified teachers. Through a shared online curriculum offered by the USG, students complete coursework focused on evidence-based practices, inclusive instruction, and individualized supports for students with disabilities.

The program leads to certification in interrelated special education (Preschool through 12 Grade) and prepares graduates to serve students typically educated in interrelated classroom settings.

Candidates develop the skills needed to:

- design and implement IEPs
- collaborate with gen ed teachers
- support students with high-incidence disabilities

Requirements For Admission to the COEHD

Once you apply and are accepted into Augusta University (AU), you'll need to apply to the Bachelor of Science Education College of Education and Human Development (COEHD) Special Education program. The following are the requirements:

- Core IMPACTS courses - 60 credit hours
 - You must provide official transcripts for all higher education institutions you have attended.
 - These credit hours can come from AU or another institution.
- GPA requirement of minimum 2.5
- 351 GACE Ethics for Teachers
- Pre-service certification application – available from AU Certification Office UH 366
- Background check - record free of criminal and disciplinary problems
- Liability insurance
